

Replenishments – Only Show Assigned Jobs

We have added to the Replenishments profile a new button called ‘Only Show Assigned Jobs’ in the general tab. When checked on the profile, it will only allow users to access replenishment jobs that have been assigned to the user, meaning that if not assigned it will display an error message to the user. Only show assigned jobs works for both Auto and Job number initiated profiles.

New Picking Creation Orderby: Shipment_detail.net_weight

A new order by clause has been added to Shipment Picking Job Creation which uses the net weight of the detail to order jobs either ascending or descending. With the addition of this clause a new column has been added to the Where tab. Also a net weight field has been added to the items tab inside a shipment header.

Selection Class Shipment Detail: Shipment Header Soft Allocation Status

A new column has been added to the Selection Class Shipment Detail called 'shipment_header.soft_allocation_status'. This will allow users to create selections for based on the soft allocation status of the shipment header, whether this be a rule master related selection or replenishment selection.

Updated By Column added to Job Enquiry

A new column has been added to Job Enquiry and Job Instructions called 'Updated By'. This will track and present the last user to make changes to the job, whether it be closing an instruction or assigning a user. This will allow further visibility on what jobs a user has done.

Disable Split and Close on Receipt Preference

Within receipt preference, an option has been added called 'Don't Allow Split'. When enabled and receipt preference has been assigned to a receipt, users will not be able to use the split and close functionality.
