
Use Expected Batch Number on Receiving

We have made several changes to receiving that will enhance user experience when receiving batch-controlled items.

When checking-in a batch-controlled item, users will now be able to adjust the batch number during receiving which will allow better control over inventory batches.


When a receipt has multiple details with the same item, after scanning the item it will present tiles that will let the user select which detail is to be checked in.

Two new options have been added to receipt preferences:



'Use Expected Batch Number' - When enabled, if the detail has expected batch information filled in, then Canary7 will automatically complete the batch number and expiry fields while making them read-only.

'Allow Select From Receipt Detail' - When enabled and after receipt confirmation on receiving, the user will be able presented an option to select from receipt detail. This option will be below the item scan field. If the user selects this option, they will be presented with a tile view of all the details on the receipt.



Disable Split and Close on Receipt Preference

Within receipt preference, an option has been added called 'Don't Allow Split'. When enabled and receipt preference has been assigned to a receipt, users will not be able to use the split and close functionality.
